Arrive in Kathmandu

Arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, Kathmandu. Traditional welcome by our airport representative. Your guide briefs about your further programme. Typical Nepali dinner served in the evening.

Kathmandu sightseeing

You will be taken for sightseeing of Kathmandu Valley to explore the vibrant city after breakfast at your hotel. Drive to famous Buddhist Stupa Swayambunath, also known as Monkey temple, on the hill of Kathmandu Valley where you can see stunning view of mountains and Kathmandu valley. This temple attracts Buddhists and tourists from around the world. Swayambhunath Stupa is the most ancient and enigmatic of all the holy shrines in Kathmandu valley. Its lofty white dome and glittering golden spire are visible from far and wide. Next is Pashupatinath, the temple of Lord Shiva. This is probably the most famous temple for Hindu in Indian Sub-continent. There is crematorium beside the temple where dead bodies are burnt to ashes. After exploring Pashupatinath you will visit fascinating sights of Patan Durbar Square, one of the most glorious examples of traditional Nepalese architecture, full of centuries old temples and palaces.

Fly to Lukla (2,845m) & trek to Phakding

You will take stunning flight to Lukla from Kathmandu. You will meet with the trekking crew upon arrival. Following a short tea break you will trek northwards up to the valley of Dudhkoshi. Descend from the small plateau into the forested valley. The trek is very easy and short today. However, the difference in altitude, in comparison with Kathmandu, can make you feel a bit difficult. After lunch you trek north towards Phakding. The trail crosses several streams and you finally reach to Phakding (2650m). You will spend your first night in this settlement from where you will have tantalizing views.

Trek to Namche Bazar (3440m)

Hike to Namche Bazaar through farmland and settlements. You will follow the Dudh Kosi northwards. This day's walk takes you through magnificent forests of rhododendron, giant fir and magnolia trees. You will cross the west fork of the river, the Bhote Kosi, and start the steep climb to Namche Bazaar. Namche is the largest Sherpa village which is called as Gateway to Mount Everest. Namche is a prosperous Sherpa village and an important trading center as well. Locals from various villages gather during the weekly bazaar and sell fresh foodstuffs.

Acclimatization day/explore around Thamo or Synboche

You will take rest in Namcha and explore the village Thamo or Synboche. Make yourself fit, physically and mentally, for the further journey. This day is for acclimatisation. We suggest you to stay active even in the rest day so that it will help you for the trekking.

Trek to Thame (3800m). Around 5 hours trekking

Today's trek begins soon after breakfast. You will leave Namcha Bazar early for Thame. Thame is the settlement where most of the famous Sherpa climbers and mountaineers were born. It is the largest village in the valley and better known as the home of Tenzing Norgay Sherpa—the first Sherpa to climb Mt Everest with Sir Edmund Hillary in 1953. Appa Sherpa, a record holder for climbing the highest peak of the world for 21 times, was also born in this village. You will interact with the local Sherpa people and know about their tradition and culture. You will spend time exploring the village and its spectacular Monastery.

Thame day hike

Today is to explore Thame. It is an outstanding trek. You will visit the Khumbu valley and explore the surroundings and Monasteries. One will be elated with the incredible hospitality of the local Sherpa community during the visit. The day will be spent exploring the rich valley. You will hike to a small peak or spend your day exploring the surrounding. You will interact with the locals. You can also meet local Sherpa artists and hear the inspiring story from the mountaineering.

Trek to Kongde (4,250m). Around (7-8) hours trek

Today's trek starts early in the morning after breakfast. You trek to the Kongde base camp. This is probably the

toughest part of this trip. It takes about 7-8 hours to reach Kongde from Thame. While climbing high above the Khumbu to the crest of Kongde one can have good view of the Himalayan ranges and the panoramic view of Mt. Everest, Nuptse, Lhotse, Ama Dablam, Thamserku and Kusumkangru peaks. Overnight at hotel.

Kongde day hike

This day is to explore Kongde. After breakfast you will start hiking to a small peak. You can see the panoramic view of mountain peaks such as Everest, Lhotse, Makalu, Cho Oyu, Ama Dablam, Thamserku. Furthermore, you can enjoy the magnificent view of Tangboche. You can see the entire Solukhumbu ranges from this place. Overnight at hotel.

Trek to Phakding. (2,610m). Approx 4-5 hours walking

After breakfast you will descend through the green forest. You can see some Himalayan Thar and very good view of the Himalayan ranges. You will trek down to Phakding from where you can have stunning view of Mt. Thamserku and range of Kangtega. As you trek to Phakding you can see the green scenery and incredible scenery. You can explore the beautiful local Sherpa village in Phakding as well. Overnight at hotel.

Trek to Lukla (2850m) 3-4hrs trekking

Retrace the way alongside the Dudh Koshi River to the small town of Lukla. You'll have a long and leisurely trek back to Lukla. You can explore the area if you like or just rest for the day.

Fly to Kathmandu

Fly from Lukla to Kathmandu, Enjoy panoramic mountain views and spend the rest of the day sightseeing, exploring, shopping or just relaxing in Kathmandu's numerous cafés and roof-top restaurants before spending the evening celebrating your achievements!

Day at leisure/ reserve day in case of flight cancel/Hotel

It's a leisure time in Kathmandu, where the rest of the day is free for shopping, sightseeing or relaxing. This is an extra day in case of bad weather. Free time to explore Kathmandu before transferring to the airport for flight back.

Drive to Airport for Return flight

Your final day in Kathmandu is a free day to you to do as you choose. Many people take the time to shop, others enjoy exploring the cultural side of the city.
